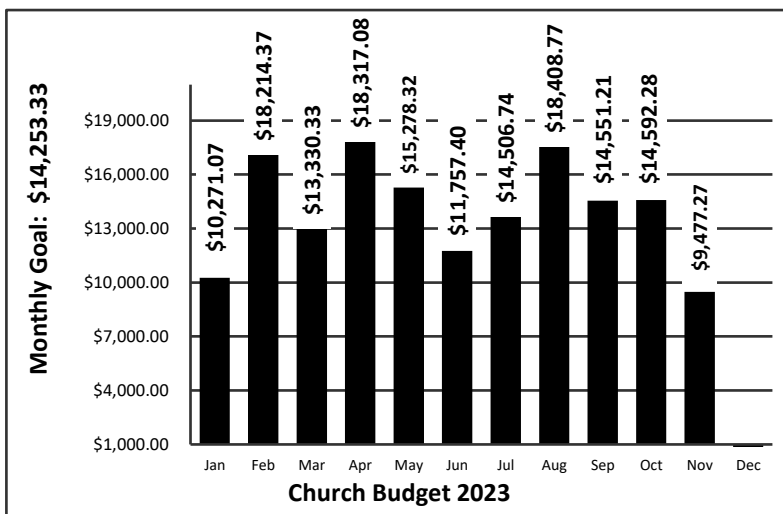

### Church Facility Beautification

Entrance Door Security Updates:	8,000.00

### **Elders Retreat (Camp MiVoden) —February 2-4**

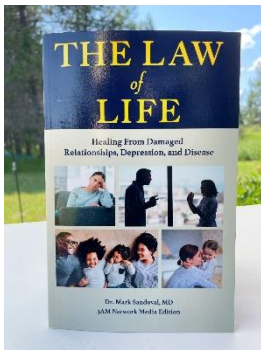

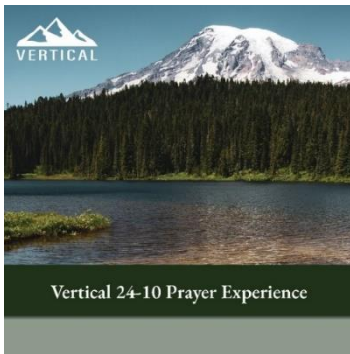


### **He's Alive Ministries Releases "The Law of Life" Media Series**

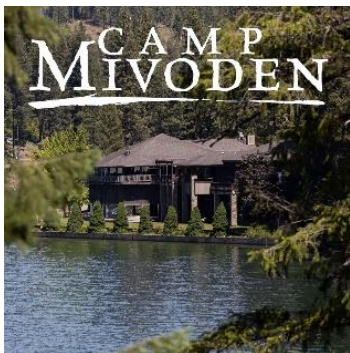
