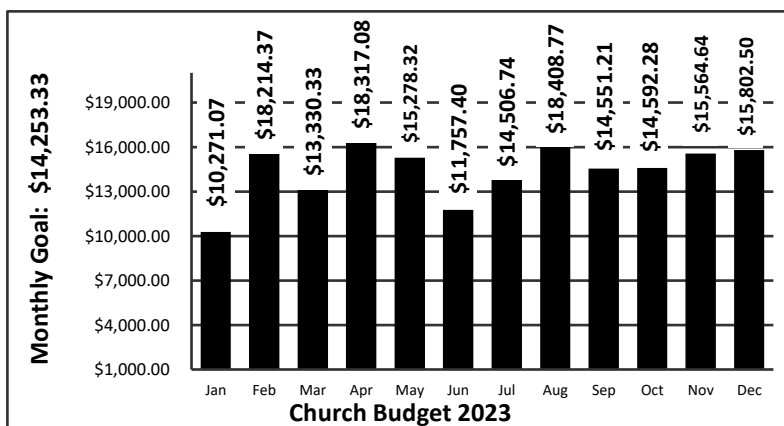

Have you seen the parking lot full, when you know the SonBridge Thrift&Gift Store, Helpline@SonBridge, and administrative offices are closed? SonBridge Center for Better Living is your local Adventist Community Services Center, extending hope to those in the Walla Walla Valley. 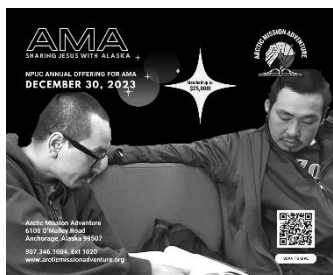
