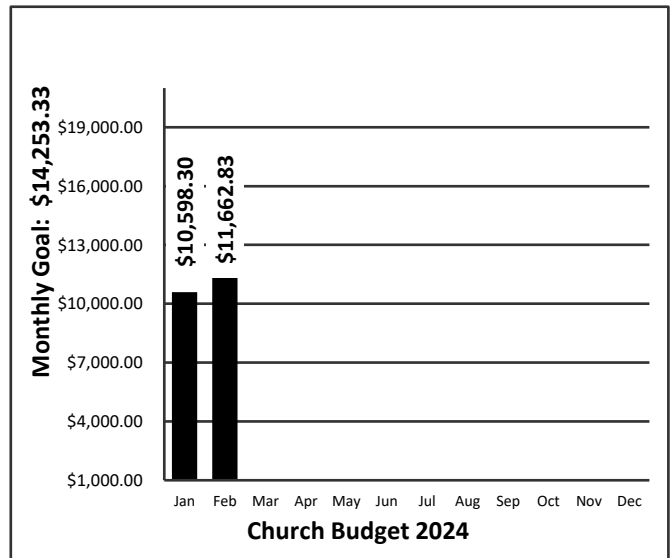
This Sabbath's Featured offering: **Camp Mivoden**

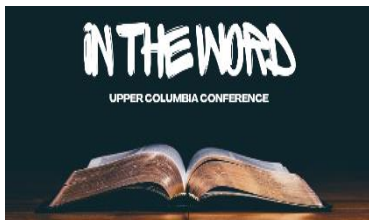

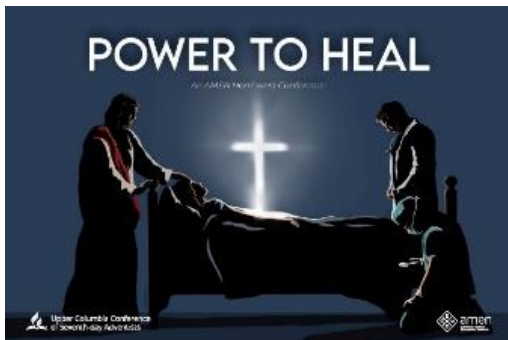
