A Message from Pastor Eric Sayler

When I was 16 I had my first consistent exposure to horses. I'd always enjoyed them, I'd done some riding, and I had always wanted my own horse but the opportunity had never presented itself. So when I had the opportunity to spend a summer working in a horse program, I jumped at it.

The learning curve was steep. My boss, a talented equestrian, took me under her wing. She patiently and consistently taught me step by step how to groom, saddle, and ride.

One of the early training experiences was riding a horse bareback while being lunged (trotted in a circle on the end of a long lead) with no bridle or any other device for me to hang on.

The goal was to develop my "seat," my connection to the horse independent of saddle, stirrups, etc.

As I rode, my boss coached me from the middle of the circle, guiding my body position, correcting my connection with the horse, and even making me aware of how my mindset impacted my seat and the horse's energy level.

I remember at one point it all became too much. Despite the coaching, the encouragement, and the guidance, my mind became mixed up, my legs got out of place, I got "behind the motion" and before I knew it I fell off, ending up on the ground in the dirt.

I'm sure you can relate. Maybe you haven't fallen off a horse, but I guarantee you've fallen... probably recently, maybe even today.

This Sabbath we're continuing our Discipleship series and discussing something that happens to all of us: What If (when) I fall?

I pray that this study will be encouraging and empowering as we explore the truth that Jesus has for us this Sabbath.

As usual, our First Service begins at 9:00, Sabbath School is at 10:15, and Second Service will be at 11:30. Feel free to join in online if you can't come in person.

I pray that this Sabbath is joy-filled and restful!
