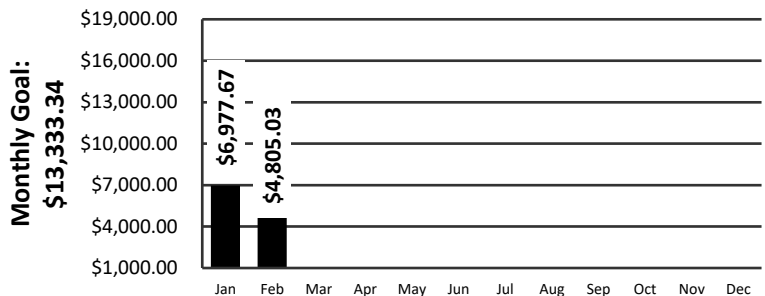

**Church Giving Report for 2022**

Media consumption is at an all-time high. People get most of their information from looking at a screen whether it is a television, computer, laptop, tablet, or a smartphone. Thus, it's a great way to reach them with the Adventist message.

*Faith for Today*, launched in 1950, was the first nationally broadcast religious program on TV. *It Is Written*, *Breath of Life* and *Jesus 101 Biblical Institute* are other television ministries operated by the North American Division providing a primary evangelistic thrust. More people are reached through TV programming than any other way.

### *Valentine's Day Editorial*

Valentine's Day is next Monday. Many of us have that very special someone who we buy flowers or chocolates for, or whatever expresses your love best to that person.

But I'm also thinking of those who have no one who will be buying them something that says "I love you." They have a quiet aching in their heart because the day of love will come and go without being noticed.

Too often we attach love to how someone looks, or how well they perform, how clever or successful they are. What if we expressed our love to those who are near and dear to us just because they're human?

My parents, for example, were teachers, preachers, musicians, well-loved people for decades. But then a dementia diagnosis and stroke changed everything three years ago. Their vocabulary is limited to a dozen words, they're not mobile, and they spend much of their time having their life's challenges cared for.

I constantly remind them that they're extremely valuable to their family and friends just for who they are, not for anything they do or give or express. They are dearly loved because God loves them first and most, and the rest of us who know them don't want to be left out of that loving celebration of value and honor.

No doubt you have people in your life like the ones I've mentioned here. And maybe you have some in your church or small group who have been going through some very lonely times during COVID. Would you please let them know you love them?

And let me hasten to add, our Creative Ministry team wants you to know we love you too!

### **Keeping the financial health of our church in mind ~ Giving Plan**

How your local church budget fits into "My Personal Giving Plan"

Like every family, the local church family has financial obligations to meet. Some are easy to see like power and heat, but many are not so obvious: children's magazines, Sabbath School Bible study guides, teaching supplies, staff salaries, cleaning services, church school operating expenses, property insurance, worthy student fund, and community outreach. These are but a few of the costs that must be met month after month as the local church seeks to be a light in the community. Because these expenses are constant, My Personal Giving Plan recommends that 3-5% of one's income be set aside for the local church budget. This systematic giving ensures that all share both in the blessings and the responsibilities of the local congregation.

The North American Division encourages the use of the "My Personal Giving Plan." This plan was developed as a guideline to assist members in systematic giving. The plan suggests that, in addition to returning 10% of a member's personal income as tithe, certain percentages may be dedicated as offerings to three main categories:

- Local Church Budget: 3-5%
- Conference Advance: 1-2%  
(Education, evangelism, VBS, summer camps, and union magazines)
- World Budget: 1-3%
