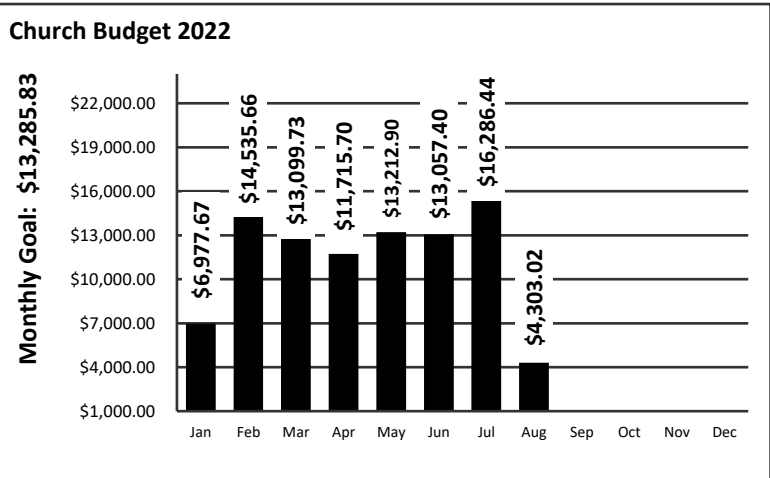
**Christian Record Services for the Blind**

## **RESULTS of the All Church Business Meeting held Sabbath evening, August 6, 2022**

Your leadership team has been busy exploring some options for you to consider regarding our Sanctuary.

**Problem Windows:** The windows allow too much light in. The seal which helps to insulate the interior from the exterior has failed. The windows need to be either replaced or removed permanently.

**Proposal #1** Replace the South Windows of the Sanctuary with all new Cool Bronze Reflective Panels. In addition to the new glass panels, special sunlight reducing window screens would be mounted on the exterior. **Proposal #1 ~ passed**

**Proposal #2** Replace the North Windows of the Sanctuary with standard Low-e glass panels. In addition to the new glass panels, special sunlight reducing window screens would be mounted on the exterior. This would help to control stage lighting for our Live-Streaming Ministry. **Proposal #2 ~ passed**

**Proposal #3** Following the replacement of the windows some sheetrock repairs would be completed on the walls of the sanctuary. Then to refresh the wall and to cover the repairs and water stains from past water leaks, a fresh coat of paint would be applied to the walls of the sanctuary. **Proposal #3 ~ passed**

**Proposal #4** To make better use of the space in the sanctuary which was originally designed as a Choral area, the vision of placing a wall which would enclose approximately 60% of the area and create a closet where the extra music stands, microphone stands, additional A/V cables etc. could be stored. This would improve the look of the front of the church and reduce the visual distractions. **Proposal #4 ~ passed**

Our Mother's Room is a space for new mothers where they can care for the needs of their infants and toddlers and still be able to engage with and follow along with the worship process in the main sanctuary. *Please do not leave children there unsupervised.*

Fathers who may need to take their turn at caring for their young ones should be aware of a multi-use space in what we call our library. There are a couple of rocking chairs for calming little ones who may need to be snuggled. This room is also a transition room where training of little ones can take place as needed. This room will continue to be a multi-function room where committees and small groups can meet during the week and during Sabbath school time.

## **Camp Wooten All Church Retreat ~ September 16 – 18**

### **About the Facilities:**

Camp Wooten is located on the Tucannon River in the Blue Mountains. There is a softball field, paved court for tennis and basketball, hiking available on forested and mountain trails, canoeing on Donnie Lake (canoes provided, flotation devices welcome – this is really more of a pond than a lake). We are working on providing archery also!

### **Accommodations:**

There is a 1930's era dining hall with fully equipped modern kitchen, 17 cabins that each sleep 11; cedar meeting hall with fireplace; several outdoor shelters; and restrooms and showers nearby. For those wanting to bring their RV's or trailers, there are only 3 maybe four sites with partial hook-ups of water, sewer and electricity.

### **Cost:**

The rate for the weekend is: \$10.00 per person per night = \$20 for a single person for the weekend. For a couple it would be \$40 for the weekend. For a Family of four or more = \$80 for the weekend. (Mom & Dad with kids = one family unit.) Grandpa & Grandma = a couple, \$40. For those coming out just for the day the rate is \$5.00 per person. We do get charged for everyone who comes into the park. Payments are to be made to the church with a note indicating for Camp Wooten Weekend. Payment prior to the weekend would be appreciated. We would like everyone to be able to go, if this price is a financial hardship, contact Carol Hargreaves or the Pastor for special arrangements.

**Food:** There will some sign-up sheets in the lobby with specific items requested for specific meals.

**Friday Supper:** Baked Potato Bar. Please bring toppings to enhance a baked potato!

**Sabbath Breakfast:** There will be a special treat presented by Carol Hargreaves. However, families should plan to bring their favorite milk or milk substitute, cereal or other main menu items.

**Sabbath Lunch:** We will be having "Haystack". Beans will be provided. We will ask you all to sign up for and bring other items to compliment this meal.

**Sabbath Supper:** We will fire up a large outdoor grill. You are invited to bring your family favorites “meats” for hotdogs or veggie burgers/grillers etc. The church will provide bread for hot dogs or burgers. Sign-ups will include condiments.

**Sunday Breakfast:** Breakfast will be prepared by the men of the church.

King Herod Agrippa had cast James, the brother of John, into prison, and sent an executioner to kill him with the sword. Seeing that many people in Jerusalem were pleased with this, he then decided to imprison Peter also.

However, when Herod sent a squadron of sixteen soldiers to arrest Peter the entire church began to pray for his release. Acts 12:5 says, “So Peter was kept in prison, but the church was earnestly praying to God for him.”

In other words, they began to pray without ceasing for Peter, for they knew that he could not be spared from God’s cause. They began to realize that they had reached a place in time, that without the special help of God, the church would not survive.
