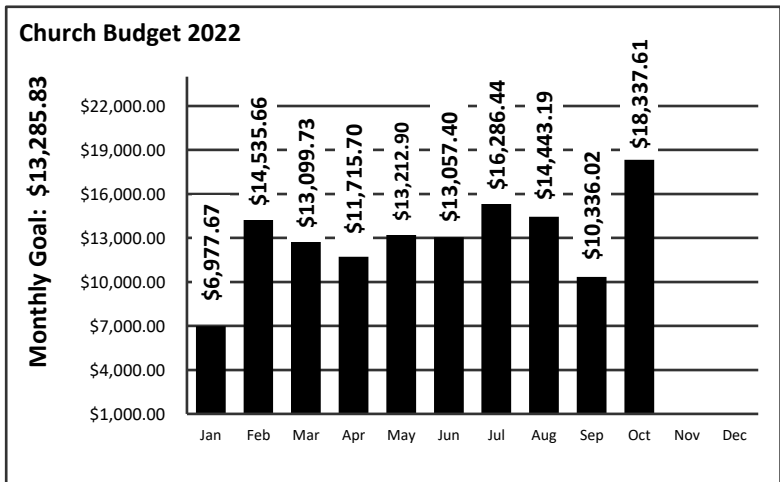

Local Church Budget

Appeal: Psalms 34:8 “Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.”

Claim His Promises: We worship God with our resources because this places us in a condition to claim His promises. The Bible is full of promises. Everett R. Storms spent a year and a half counting Bible promises and came up with 7,487 promises made by God to humankind. God’s promises have three



characteristics: they are true, all can claim them, and they are often conditional. Paul wrote about his confidence in God’s promises: “For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ.” (2 Cor. 1:20a). When God says, “Yes,” nobody can say, “No!” Several are conditional to faith and obedience as two essential requisites (Matt. 21:22; Isa. 59:2). About obedience, Ellen G. White writes: “All who obey Him may with confidence claim the fulfillment of His promises.”—

Christ's Object Lesson, p. 145. An incident in the life of Fred Stirewalt, a farmer from Hollister, California, shows the value of obedience in claiming God's promises. One afternoon Fred observed that army beetles had covered his field. Immediately, he realized the disastrous outcome awaiting: these small creatures eat until there is nothing green left. Feeling powerless, he had an insightful conversation with his daughter Helen: Helen asked, "Daddy, you pay your tithe, don't you?" "Yes," he replied. "Then why not ask God to keep His promise and drive the beetles away?" Convinced by these words, they knelt and prayed, claiming the promise of Malachi 3:10, 11: "Bring the whole tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. Test me in this," says the Lord Almighty, ... I will prevent pests from devouring your crops, and the vines in your fields will not drop their fruit before it is ripe,..." Right after praying, they saw a cloud of blackbirds descending on their fields. The blackbirds remained for a short time, but there wasn't a beetle left when they flew away. God has a heaven full of blessings for those who will cooperate with Him. This week, as we worship with our tithe and regular offerings we are placing ourselves in a position to claim His promises.

Prayer: Lord, we are thankful for Your promises of spiritual and temporal blessings. We claim them over our lives. Remove all doubts and unfaithfulness that could be obstacles.

Isaac Peterson, Student Pastor 2022-2023

Have you met our new Student Pastor yet? I sat down with him and asked a few questions. I hope this helps you get to know him a bit better.

So Isaac, where are you from?

I am originally from Northern California, not far from Auburn where I attended Pine Hills Adventist Academy for high-school and later went to Pacific Union College for Emergency Services. I started California fire training, I did some

search and rescue work but before I completed that degree I turned my focus to ministry. I interned as a youth pastor/worship pastor at the Paradise SDA Church for two summers and decided to pursue pastoral ministry by going back to school at Andrews University. I was there for a relatively short time and then decided to be closer to home, my girlfriend, and to save money I recently transferred to Walla Walla University where I will finish my Theology degree come 2024.

There was mention of a girl friend in that response. Do you want to tell us any more about that subject?

Well, I met her while on a mission trip. She is wonderful and this relationship is still under development.

Were you a student leader in your Academy experience? Hold offices in ASB or class officer, anything of that nature?

I was class pastor at Pine Hills Adventist Academy all 4 years of high school and was Religious Vice President my senior year.

Our Pastor Eric was a Wrangler while at Big Lake, Oregon. Did you ever work at a summer camp?

I never worked at a camp but I was a worship leader and staff member for Maranatha Ultimate Workout trips :) SIDE NOTE: The Ultimate Workout is a unique mission project designed for teenagers in high school. Stripped of electronics, parents, and other familiar comforts, volunteers step into the mission field in search of a fresh perspective on the world, relationships, and God. During the project, volunteers live in spartan conditions while building a church or school, coordinating outreach for the local community, and strengthening their personal connection to Jesus Christ. The Ultimate Workout is Maranatha's most adventurous project—and the most popular!

So to get a glimpse of how you grew up, what was the first job you ever were hired for?

My first paying job, I think it was working as a warehouse worker at a feed store in California bucking hay and loading horse feed!

Do you know what specific area(s) of our church you will be working in or with?

My official duties include aiding in pastoral care, some leadership in music – mostly with the youth and young adult groups. Also Pastor Eric will include me in a variety of church functions so I can continue to build experience in church organization practices and procedures.

You already seem to have a bit of experience in pastor type of work. What is/are your personal goal(s) as you go through this Eastgate/WWU experience?

I want to further develop my experience in youth ministry in a way that establishes empowerment of leadership within the youth themselves and in stating mentorship from the young adults down to the youth. I also want to further understand some nuance pastoral skills where I have less experience; like baptismal studies, leading bible studies and starting study/support groups.

Where do you see yourself once you have completed your year here with us at Eastgate and as you complete your Theology Degree here at WWU?

I plan to go where God leads me but for now I hope to primarily focus on music ministry and youth mentorship.

What are some of your personal interests and ways you like to spend your recreation time? Are you a team sport person or more of an individual recreational individual?

I am an active outdoors enthusiast and can be caught mountain biking, rock climbing, backpacking, running etc. I also enjoy overlanding and rock crawling especially when I can be behind a camera and develop quality photo/video content. I am a songwriter/music performer who also enjoys podcasting and interviewing people. Traveling is also at the top of the list and being able to do all those side hobbies while in a plane or car in whatever country or state; that's a good time! So for recreation?
